Challenge Event Terms and Conditions

TCS London Marathon, April 2027, London

By applying for entry into the TCS London Marathon 2027 (the “Event”) in support of The London Community Foundation, I confirm I understand and agree to the following terms and conditions.

Registration and participation

1. I understand that in order to take part in the Event, I must register with London Marathon Events Ltd (the “Event Organiser”). Failure to complete the Event Organiser’s registration by any applicable deadline may mean I am unable to participate in the Event.

2. I understand that this Event is organised by the Event Organizer, who is solely responsible for the conduct and operation of the Event, including all health and safety requirements. I will read the Event Organiser’s Terms and Conditions for the Event and I will comply with any specific Event rules given by them.

3. I will be aged 18 years or over on the date of the Event.

4. If my application for a charity place in the Event, in support of The London Community Foundation, is successful, I will pay The London Community Foundation within 5 working days of being offered a charity place, a non-refundable registration fee of £100 (the “Registration Fee”). The Registration Fee will be paid to a bank details provided to me by The London Community Foundation, to secure my place in the Event.

5. I acknowledge that I cannot swap, sell or transfer my place in the Event or allow anyone else to participate on my behalf.

6. I understand that The London Community Foundation:

- a.** reserves the right to refuse my application for a charity place in the Event, as a large number of applications are received beyond the number of places available. The London Community Foundation is not obliged to notify me as to why my application has been refused; and
- b.** reserves the right to withdraw my charity place in the Event at any time in exceptional circumstances, including if I do anything that brings, or could bring, The London Community Foundation reputation into disrepute or if I do not comply with these terms and conditions.

7. I will inform The London Community Foundation's Development Team immediately, by emailing philanthropy@londoncf.org.uk, if I am unable to take part in the Event. When my withdrawal is acknowledged by The London Community Foundation, I will not be liable to raise any further sponsorship.

Charity Place Deferral:

8. Participants holding a charity place may request to defer their participation to the following year. I understand that deferral requests must be submitted in writing to philanthropy@londoncf.org.uk as soon as possible and are subject to the following conditions:

a. Registration Fees: Registration fees are non-refundable. If my deferral is approved by The London Community Foundation, I acknowledge that I must pay the registration fee for the year to which my place is deferred.

b. Fundraising Commitment: I must have raised at least 50% of the agreed fundraising target (excluding Gift Aid).

c. Fundraising Carryover: Fundraising raised in the current year may be carried over to the year to which my place is deferred. I understand that the fundraising target may increase for that year and I agree to meet the new fundraising target.

d. Availability & Approval: I understand that deferral of my charity place is not guaranteed and is subject to availability and approval by The London Community Foundation.

e. Subsequent Deferrals: I understand that if I am unable to take part in the event during my deferred year and wish to request a further deferral, this will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Any further deferral is not guaranteed and will be subject to The London Community Foundation's discretion and the availability of places.

Minimum fundraising target

9. I pledge to raise a minimum of £2000 in aid of The London Community Foundation, excluding Gift Aid and the Registration Fee (the "Minimum Fundraising Target") through my

participation in the Event. I understand the aim of this Event is to raise as much above the Minimum Fundraising Target as possible.

10. I Understand that the sum of £2000 must be paid to The London Community Foundation by the fundraising deadline which is six weeks after the Event date (the “Fundraising Deadline”).

11. If I register before 1 November 2026, I pledge to fundraise and/or donate £500 of my Minimum Fundraising Target to The London Community Foundation by 31 December 2026 in order to show commitment to my charity place. Failure to do so may result in The London Community Foundation withdrawing my charity place in the Event.

12. If at any point I feel unable to raise the Minimum Fundraising Target, I will inform The London Community Foundation’s Development Team immediately by emailing philanthropy@londoncf.org.uk, so that they can provide support with my fundraising plans.

Fundraising

13. I will use only lawful means to fundraise in aid of The London Community Foundation and will not do anything that harms or is likely to harm The London Community Foundation reputation.

14. I will comply with any fundraising guidance or advice issued by The London Community Foundation and abide by the Fundraising Regulator’s Code of Fundraising Practice available [here](#).

15. I will make clear to everyone supporting my fundraising that I am raising funds ‘in aid of’ The London Community Foundation.

16. I will collect money in aid of The London Community Foundation in connection with the Event only.

17. My fundraising will not include:

- a.** Raising funds by carrying out door-to-door or unsolicited collections.
- b.** Collecting funds in any public place without first obtaining written permission from The London Community Foundation, a license from the local authority and any other licences or consent as required by law and the Fundraising Regulator’s Code of Fundraising Practice.
- c.** Collecting funds on private property (including shops, pubs etc.) without first obtaining written permission of the owner of the private property.
- d.** Conducting any raffle or lottery without first contacting The London Community

Foundation and following any steps required by The London Community Foundation.

18. I agree that Gift Aid payments cannot count towards the fundraising pledge and instead will be considered funds raised over and above the Minimum Fundraising Target.

19. The London Community Foundation can terminate my authority to fundraise in aid of the charity at any time by sending written notice to the email or postal address I provided at the point of registration.

Donations and payment terms

20. All monies raised in aid of The London Community Foundation are held on trust for The London Community Foundation and I understand that I have a legal responsibility to ensure that all funds raised in connection with the Event are paid to The London Community Foundation.

21. I will pay all monies raised in connection to the Event by one of the following means:

a. Via an online giving platform (The London Community Foundation uses Enthuse for the Event. Other platforms can be used if agreed with the team. We reserve the right to change our preferred choice of platform at any time before the Event"

b. To The London Community Foundation bank account by using the banking details provided by The London Community Foundation (I understand these will only be made available upon request).

c. By cheque, CAF vouchers, Benevity platform, made payable to 'The London Community Foundation' and sent to: The London Community Foundation, Registered office: Canopi, 82 Tanner Street, London, SE1 3GN. The London Community Foundation is a company limited by guarantee registered in England and Wales, company number 4383269 and charity registered in England and Wales 1091263. 24.

22. I understand that if the Minimum Fundraising Target has not been paid by the Fundraising Deadline, I may have to pay any shortfall from my own personal funds within one month of the Fundraising deadline date or in instalments to be agreed in writing with The London Community Foundation.

23. I understand that if I withdraw for any reason from the Event, any monies raised will be non-refundable and will be treated as a donation to The London Community Foundation payable in accordance with clause 21.

24. I will make it clear when fundraising in connection with the Event, that the money is not given subject to any conditions and that the funds will not be returned if the Event is cancelled, or I do not complete the Event.

25. I will send The London Community Foundation my completed sponsorship forms with details of the names and addresses of sponsors together with the amounts donated or pledged no later than 4 weeks after the Event. This will allow The London Community Foundation to process Gift Aid on the donations.

Personal data

26. I understand that The London Community Foundation will use the information provided by me when registering for the Event for the purpose of promoting and administering my charity place in the Event. The London Community Foundation may also contact me to discuss my fundraising.

27. I give permission for my personal information to be passed on to the Event Organiser by The London Community Foundation for the purposes of the organisation, promotion and administration of the Event.

28. The personal information provided by me when registering for the Event may be used for the purpose of sending me communications in line with the consent given when registering for the Event.

29. All personal data held by The London Community Foundation will be handled and used in accordance with applicable privacy laws and The London Community Foundation's [Privacy Notice](#).

Health, safety and fitness

30. I understand that the Event will be physically challenging and there is a risk of injury. I will prepare myself for the physical challenge of the Event and I will obtain confirmation from my doctor to ensure that I am medically fit to participate in the Event. I confirm that I will not participate in the Event if for any reason I am not, or if I feel that I am not, in a fit state to take part and I confirm that it is my responsibility to seek expert medical advice if appropriate.

Liability

The London Community Foundation is a company limited by guarantee registered in England and Wales, company number 4383269 and charity registered in England and Wales 1091263. Registered office: Canopi, 82 Tanner Street, London, SE1 3GN

31. Nothing in these terms limits any liability which cannot legally be limited, including death or personal injury caused by negligence.

32. Subject to clause 31, I understand that the activities and/or events I organise to raise funds in aid of The London Community Foundation are my responsibility, including but not limited, to all costs and liability. The London Community Foundation bears no liability whatsoever for any events and/or activities I may organise. The London Community Foundation shall not be liable for any injury, damage or loss to me, my property or to any third party that might occur because of the fundraising activities and/or events that I organise.

33. Subject to clause 31, I understand that I take part in the Event at my own risk, and I will not hold The London Community Foundation or any connected persons, responsible for any accident, injury or illness to me, for any damage to my property, or for any losses that might occur as a result of my participation in the Event.
