costs in relation to the	costs. For the London Refugee Response, 5% of every donation will go towards the
Fund?	management of the fund and our costs. We incur costs on activities such as
	managing funds, governance, and reporting, assessing and distributing grants to
	charities and monitoring their activity, communicating with donors. This
	contribution to LCF will be kept under review by LCF's Board of Trustees, as with our
	work on other emergency appeals like COVID. This will include monitoring volume
	and value of funds raised to be managed, volume and value of grants being
	committed and team costs to deliver. Working with other London Funders partners
	and GLA means we can be as expedient as possible on how the funds are
	distributed.
